Based on ideal body weight. Overweight patients do not have larger tracheas.

ET tube size based on body weight is used as a guideline only. Select size based on species, breed, body condition score, conformation, etc. Select largest size that will not traumatize larynx, trachea, or surrounding structures. Length should measure ~ from incisors to point of scapula/shoulder (thoracic inlet). Diameter should measure ~ ¾ tracheal diameter (palpate trachea). Select at least three ET tubes of slightly different sizes when preparing for anesthesia. Check cuffs for leaks. Inflate cuff to ensure a seal, but do not overinflate.
